



HORN SIGNALS
Be aware of sound signals on the River Thames.



CAUTION
Be aware of boat traffic.



RED MARKING
It is prohibited to sail in areas marked with red.



DOWN STREAM TRAFFIC
Follow instructions at bridges.



UP STREAM TRAFFIC
Follow instructions at bridges.



BOAT MOORINGS
The brown areas along the river. Keep a distance.



STEERING OF THE BOAT

- Twist to the left for forward
- Twist right for reverse
- Stay to the right hand bank
- Give way to all other river users
- Be aware of unpowered craft approaching from behind

1 TEDDINGTON LOCK

First built in 1810, marks the limit of the tidal Thames.

2 TROWLOCK ISLAND

The name derives from Trow, a type of barge averaging 50–60 tons. Harry Gibbs' boat building firm was located on the island in 1910.

3 STEVENS EYOT

4 KINGSTON RAIL BRIDGE

It carries the Kingston Loop Line train service from London Waterloo station

5 KINGSTON ROAD BRIDGE

Until Putney Bridge was opened in 1729, Kingston Bridge was the only crossing of the river between London Bridge and Staines Bridge.

6 RAVEN'S AIT

7+8 THAMES DITTON ISLAND

9 HAMPTON COURT PALACE

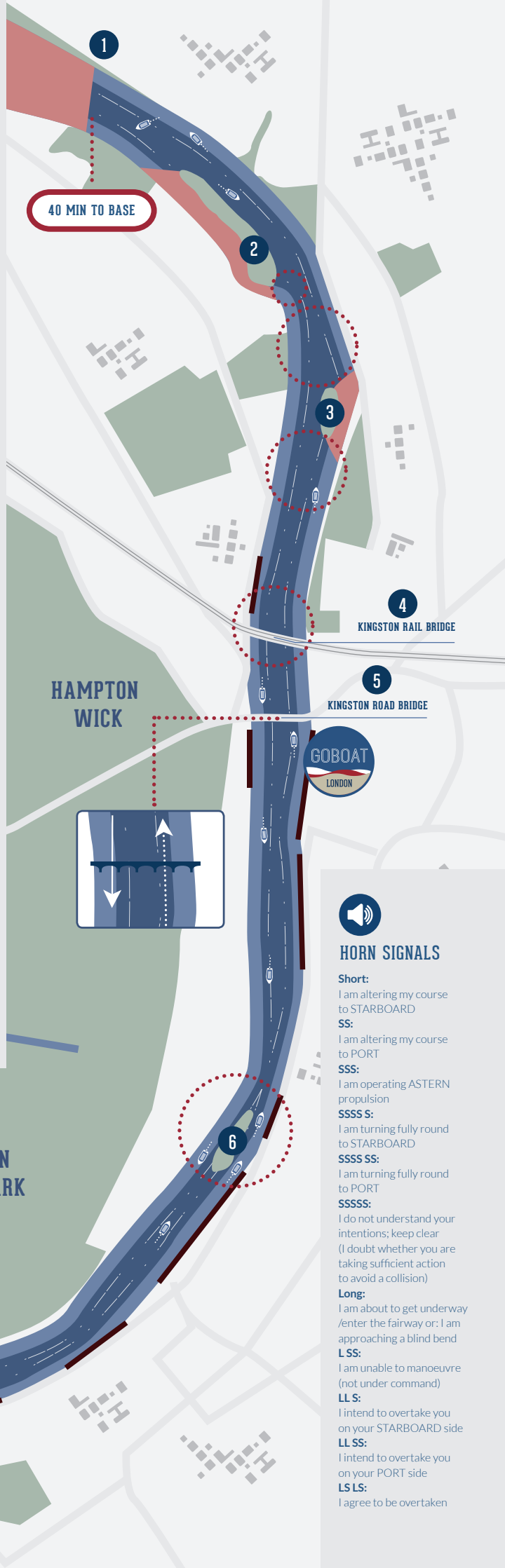
Building of the palace began in 1515 for Cardinal Thomas Wolsey, a favourite of King Henry VIII.

10 HAMPTON COURT BRIDGE

The most upstream crossing of the Thames within Greater London; uniquely only one bank is within the county. First built 1753.

11 MOLESLEY LOCK

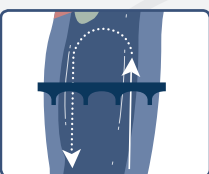
The lock was built by the City of London Corporation in 1815 and was rebuilt by the Thames Conservancy in 1906.

HORN SIGNALS

Short:
I am altering my course to STARBOARD
SS:
I am altering my course to PORT
SSS:
I am operating ASTERN propulsion
SSSS:
I am turning fully round to STARBOARD
SSSSS:
I am turning fully round to PORT
SSSSS:
I do not understand your intentions; keep clear (I doubt whether you are taking sufficient action to avoid a collision)
Long:
I am about to get underway /enter the fairway or: I am approaching a blind bend
L SS:
I am unable to manoeuvre (not under command)
LL S:
I intend to overtake you on your STARBOARD side
LL SS:
I intend to overtake you on your PORT side
LS LS:
I agree to be overtaken
